GENERAL ASPECTS TO BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN THE APPLICATION OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE.

□ AIMS OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE

THERE ARE THREE FUNDAMENTAL AIMS OF THIS QUESTIONNAIRE:

- To place the focus of attention on the necessity to consider the problem of violence against disabled women.
- To act as a tool in obtaining quantitative and qualitative information of the problem.
- To provide professionals with a protocol for the collection of information that will be used as:
 - An instrument of identification and valuation of the possible existence of a situation of violence in disabled women.
 - A resource for the planning of individual actions in different areas of social intervention.

□ COMPONENTS OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE

This questionnaire has two distinctively different components:

- THE REPORT REGISTER SHEET, which reflects exclusively those items related with detailed complaints.
- THE SITUATIONS OF VIOLENCE EVALUATION DOCUMENT, which contains
 - Items with open and closed questions.
 - A register of the final assessments of the dimensions examined during the interview.
 - An observational register of possible signs of violence detected during the interview.

□ WHO IT IS AIMED AT AND ITS APPLICATION

The first part of the questionnaire is aimed at those people in charge of filling in the register of reports of ill-treatment.

The second part of the register is aimed at any professional in general from a public or private entity and/or NGO that is in contact with disabled women, and in particular those professionals that have the possibility of applying preventive and/or social intervention programmes.

The application of the questionnaire is individual, and should be carried out in a flexible manner, which implies not following each question word for word but more as a general guideline or script, so that the professionals can carry out an interview and efficiently register those fundamentally qualitative aspects of each of the dimensions mentioned in said questionnaire, and that in some way may be directly or indirectly related with the phenomenon of VIOLENCE.

Furthermore, the professionals should always bear in mind the idiosyncrasies of each person, making note of all information that they may consider pertinent and that may be exerting a great influence on the causes and/or the effects produced by the violence.
